

Anaula Nature Resort



Anaula Nature Resort offers you 3 and 4 day tours consisting of a complete journey to the interior of Suriname. Standard departure days for the 3 days (2 nights at the resort) are every Monday, Wednesday and Friday and for the 4-day (3 nights) is the standard departure on the Friday. During your trip we will make several trips, such as a village walk, visit to the Ferulassi Sroomversnellingen and an adventurous boat trip. Also a cultural performance conducted by Maroons, the inhabitants of the area around Anaula, will not be remembered.

Location:

A walk around the island takes about 30 minutes. The island is approximately 180 km away from the capital Paramaribo and is about 4 hours drive and 1 hour sailing. Anaula Nature Resort is located in the malaria-free area according to the Surinamese health authority (Buro Openbare Gezondheidszorg). Swallowing malaria tablets is therefore not necessary.

Tourdescription:

For travelers who have opted for the 3- day / 2 nights Anaula tour.

Day 01: Paramaribo – Anaula

Today we begin our natural and cultural experience and leave from Paramaribo in the southern direction. By the way, we pass the impressive forest rivers and villages located on this road. After about 190 km, we arrive at Atjoni's lighthouse, and then start with an energetic coral tour. We travel for about 50

minutes by motorized coral to the comfortable Anaula Nature Resort, located at the foot of the Ferulassi Valley, where you will also spend the night. During this cruise we will find breathtaking nature and various marble villages. We also pass the turbulent Jaw-Jaw rapids.

After a light lunch in buffet form in our beautiful dining room, it will be "check in." Here you will have the opportunity to explore the resort. In the morning we go to a nearby swimming facility, in the Ferulassi rapids, where we can relax, swim and enjoy a natural spa bath. For dinner, we go for an exciting adventure in search of fishermen. You can also enjoy the beautiful starry sky during this night's cruise and experience the total silence of the Amazon rain forest.

Day 2: Anaula (Village walk and cultural performance)

After breakfast we go to the village of New Aurora for a village walk by coral. During the tour of the village, you will meet local people and their unique way of life and their traditional habits and uses. We visit the mission post, including a church, a primary school and a medical post.

At about 16.30 we make a forest walk on the island where the resort is located. During this forest walk you will get an explanation of the local medical use of plants. During the domestic war in 1986, the jungle commands of Ronnie Brunswijk visited the island for their "immortality rituals." The remains of these rituals on the island remind us of this unique piece of history.

In the evenings you can enjoy a delicious dinner. After dinner we can enjoy a cultural dance performance. Traditional dance such as the Seketi, Awasa and Bandamba will be performed for us. Our guide will give an explanation of the content and meaning of these dances.

Note: The cultural dance evening is only offered for a minimum of 8 guests. van 8 gasten.

Day 3 Anaula – Paramaribo

This morning you can fill in to your own needs. You can swim, go for a hike, relax by the pool or in a hammock, or enjoy nature in peace. After lunch we return to Atjoni, where we depart for Paramaribo by bus.

4 days tour/ 3 nights

Day 1: Paramaribo - Anaula

Today we start our natural and cultural experience and depart from Paramaribo in southern direction. On the way we pass the impressive giant trees and villages along this road. After about 190 km the road ends and we arrive at Atlii to embark on an exciting canoe

trip. We sail about 50 minutes by motorized canoe to the comfortable Anaula Nature Resort, located at the foot of the Ferullas rivals, where you will spend the night. During this cruise you enjoy a breathtaking nature and we will pass several Maroon villages. We also pass the impressive Jaw-Jaw rapid.

After a light lunch in our lovely dining room check-in takes place. Hereafter you can explore the resort. In the afternoon we sail by canoe to a nearby swimming in the Ferullasi rapids, where we can relax, swim and enjoy a natural whirlpool. For dinner we face an exciting adventure in search of caimans. You can also enjoy the beautiful starry sky and the complete silence of the Amazon rainforest during this night cruise.

Day 2: Village walk and cultural performance...

After breakfast we go to the village of New Aurora for a village walk by coral. During the tour of the After breakfast we sail by canoe to the village Nieuw Aurora for a village walk. During this trip you will meet the local people and their unique way of life and their traditional customs and habits. Among others we visit a church, a primary school and a medical post. Around 16:30 we have planned a walk through the forest on the island of Anaula. During this walk you will receive information about the local medicinal use of plants. During the civil war in 1986, the Jungle Commandos Ronnie came to this island for their "immortality rituals". The remnants of these rituals on the island remind us of this unique part of history. In the evening, enjoy a delicious dinner. A free evening where you can visit our lobby with relaxing sofas.

Day 3: More cultural experience

Today it is Sunday. So you have the opportunity to experience a church service in the village. You will witness a typical Saramaccan service. In the afternoon you are free to spend your time. The hammock camps are there for your

convenience. A walk on the island is recommended and you can enjoy the sound of the birds or chill at one of jetties at the riverside. Reading a book in our lovely pool under the gazebo is also not unattractive idea. After dinner you can enjoy cultural dances. Traditional dances such as the Seketi, Awasa and Bandamba will be performed. Our guide will explain the meaning of these dances. Note: cultural dance is only offered at a minimum of 8 guests.

Day 4: Anaula – Paramaribo

This morning you freely spend your time. After lunch we return to Atjoni for departure for Paramaribo by bus.

Included in the tour

- Transportation on tour days by bus or by boat
- Boat trips by canoe with an outboard motor
- Forest and village walks accompanied by local guides
- 3 meals a day during your stay at the resort
- Coffee, tea, lemonade and water throughout the day
- Accommodation in comfortable cabins with private bath and toilet
- Bath and hand towels are provided, it is not permitted to use them outside the accommodations. It is recommended to bring your own towel if you go swimming. Shampoo and shower gel are provided.
- Professional Dutch and English speaking guide throughout the tour program.

- Softdrinks and alcoholis drinks
