

## Bergendal – Brownsberg – Ston Island Tour

- Ston Island, also called Ston Island, is a peninsula in the Brokopondostuw Lake in the Brokopondo district. Here is a beautiful recreation resort. In the reservoir with the characteristic tree tops in the water you can swim, sail and fish. The beautiful places and cabins guarantee a relaxed stay.

### Ligging:

- Berg and Dal (Surinamese: Bergi) is a village and former plantation of Suriname, about 100 km south of Paramaribo in the north of the district Brokopondo on the left bank of the river Suriname.
- Approximately 130 km south of Paramaribo, northwest of the Van Blommenstein reservoir, is the approximately 6000 ha size Brownsberg Nature Park.

### Tourdescription:

#### **Day 1: Paramaribo – Bergendal - Brownsberg**

At 7 o'clock we leave Paramaribo for the Bergendal Activity Center where you arrive around 9:30. Here you can make a choice to take part in one of the different nature-oriented activities such as boat trips from the Activity Center to New Lombe where you can relax or a kayak or canopy tour that is very adrenaline. A historic walk on Bergendal is also possible. Through this walk you will discover the surprising history of Bergendal.

After your completed activity (s) we continue our way to Brownsberg. There we make a short

walk to the viewpoint where we have a very nice view of the Blommenstein reservoir. After this you can still enjoy a delicious lunch. In the evening you can still enjoy a dinner full of love prepared by the cook. (L, D)

### **Day 2 Brownsberg – Ston eiland**

You will be awake in the midst of nature through the roar of howler monkeys. On this day a visit to the traps is on the program. After your breakfast we make a beautiful walk to the Leo and / or Irene fall. After this, you decide how you want to fill in your day. You can relax, swim or simply enjoy in your hammock with an exciting booklet in your hand. After lunch we travel to our next accommodation on ston island. We go via the maroon villages to Ston island. Here you can relax from the cool water and enjoy the most breathtaking view in this area. (O, L, D)

After breakfast there is an opportunity to kayak, swim and / or relax. After lunch we return to Paramaribo. (O, L)
