


Santigrón Tour



De tour naar Santigrón is een gevarieerde tour vol cultuur, natuur en geschiedenis.

Location:

Santrigrón (zandgrond) is located on the Saramacca River, but can also be reached by road. The village was founded by a Saramaccan who moved to the coastal plain in the 19th century in search of work. There was already peace between the Maroons and the colonial government, so they could safely get out of their hiding place. The man is said to have found work at a timber plantation and later had his family come over. That is how the village came into being. The wood carving on the houses is Sarramacan, Sarramacaners make a relief in different wood tones.

Tour description:

We drive to Lelydorp, where a visit is made to the local market. During this short bus ride we will take you through the suburbs of the city. The guide tells you about the villages and the countryside and other interesting

sights. Once arrived at Santigrón you will be welcomed. Santigrón is a Maroon village where the Saramaccans live near the Saramacca river, this is a traditional village closest to Paramaribo (30 km). Santigrón literally means: sandy soil. The clear white savannah sand of the old coastal plain of Suriname is very pleasant and suitable for your vacation. The village has approximately 1750 inhabitants, but the village will become more and more urban due to its location. You walk through the village where the guide tells you about nature, history, culture and attractions in the village. And how much influence the Maroon culture has on the residents every day.

During this tour you also get a personal impression of the history of the village, the rich cultural life of the Maroons and the normal daily life. You meet many villagers and you see many sights, such as the local school, the church and the main square. You
