Highlights Tour:

- Spotting dolphins
- Fishing village Rust en Werk

Ligging:

The district Commewijne is one of the oldest plantation areas of Suriname. The district is located on the right bank of the Suriname River, opposite Paramaribo. Commewijne is bounded in the north by the Atlantic Ocean, in the west by the districts Paramaribo and Wanica, in the south by the district Para and in the East by the district Marowijne. The main place is New Amsterdam.

General informatie:

Rust en Werk was a coffee plantation on the Commewijne River in the Commewijne district in Suriname.

Tour discription:

This tour starts at the pier of Leonsberg where we cross the river by the traditional boat. During this 3-hour tour you will first look for the dolphins and spend some time on the spot. Then you sail to the village of Rust en Werk where you can enjoy some local snacks. During your retreat you enjoy the beautiful sunset, while it slowly gets dark. With luck you can also encounter pelicans and other bird species during this trip
